DISCIPLINE

Every member of the club has signed up to one or more codes of conduct and is expected to maintain a high standard of behaviour. Our codes of conduct can only be effective if there is a disciplinary process to support them. It is essential that the club is seen to be fair and consistent in dealing with misconduct.

The club committee will deal with serious breaches of codes of conduct as and when they arise. The committee will have several options available to it depending on the seriousness of the actual case it is considering.

Possible sanctions include:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning
- Exclusion from specified number of matches
- Exclusion from team for the remainder of the season
- Refusal to register with team for future season
- Exclusion from membership of the club

The Club aims to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for players to develop their football skills. To enable this to happen the Club expects that all players and parents conduct themselves in a sensible and respectful manner towards club officials, their team, opposition players and match/league officials at all times.

Players (their parents/guardian/carer) are responsible for the payment of any yellow or red cards received during a game.
